Club Championship (2017/18 Season)

Tournament Dates:

The Club Championship will be played over two consecutive days, Thursday and Friday, March 15 and 16, 2018.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee will be \$35.00 for this two-day event. The entry fee plus green fees are due in full no later than Saturday, March 10, 2018. Standard HOA cancellation rules will apply.

Signup Deadline:

Sign up in the Pro Shop by 5:00 PM on Saturday, March 10, 2018. *Players must declare the preferred Men's Tees in which they wish to compete.*

Qualification Requirements:

To qualify, entrants must be a member of the Sun City Shadow Hills Men's Golf Club and the SCGA and have a verifiable handicap index through GHIN. Entrants must have a minimum of twenty (20) rounds posted on GHIN during the twelve-month period prior to the signup deadline and at least five (5) of those rounds played in related Men's Club events, i.e., Monday League Play or Monday group, Tuesday Group, Thursday events, or Saturday groups.

Eligible Handicaps:

Handicaps will be based on the entrant's *lowest handicap index from the 6-month period prior to March 2018, i.e., September 1, 2017 to March 1, 2018.* The GHIN app will show you your handicap history so you can determine the HI that will be used.

Format:

This is a two-day, 36-hole, individual medal event, from either the White or Green tees divided into Flights by handicap:

- Overall Club Champion --- This Low Gross Winner will emerge from all the players from the White Tees and will be declared the Club Champion.
- <u>Net White-Tee Champion</u>---This division is open to all players. Flights, if needed, TBD based on the number of sign-ups. The Low Gross Club Champion will <u>not</u> be eligible for overall white-tee Low Net awards.
- <u>Net Green-Tee Champion</u>---This division is open to all players. Flights TBD based on the number of sign-ups.
- <u>Super-Senior Net Champion</u>, Green Tees---All participants must have reached his 75th birthday on or before Saturday, March 10, 2018. Flights TBD based on the number of sign-ups. This Champion who is at least 75 years of age will emerge from all the players from the Super-Senior Green Tees and will <u>not</u> be eligible for overall green-tee Low Net awards.
- Three members will be eligible to participate in the SCGA Tournament of Champions with the entry fee paid by the Shadow Hills Men's Club. They will be the (1) Club Champion, (2) Net White-Tee Champion, and (3) the lower net of the Net Green-Tee Champion and the Super-Senior Net Champion.

Ties:

If a tie exists for first place in any of the categories (Gross, Net-White, Net-Green or Super-Senior Net), a three-hole aggregate playoff (Medal/stroke play) will commence on hole 1 (or 10) immediately after the second round of play or as soon as practical. Handicaps will be based on "strokes as they fall." If, at the end of three holes, the participants are still tied, the format will be "sudden death" until a winner is determined. The Tournament Chair, or Event Committee Chair, and/or Club President (or designated proxy) must accompany the players in any event.

Payout:

Scores from each flight will be ranked from lowest to highest for each day and for the overall 2 days combined. There will be separate payouts for both Thursday and Friday in each Flight (based on the number of participants in the Tournament). There will also be payouts for the combined 2-day scores in each Flight. Thus, if a participant has a poor round on Thursday, there will be an opportunity to earn prize money with a good round on Friday. Also, the Club Champion (Low Gross Winner) will be awarded an additional cash prize. If a tie exists for any remaining positions qualifying for prize money, the prize money will be combined and divided by the number of players tied. For example, if the second three places are to be paid and 5 players tie for second, the prize money for 2nd, 3rd, and 4th place finishes will be added together and divided by the 5 players.

Hole-in-One:

Any golfer scoring a hole-in-one during either round of the Club Championship will be entitled to receive the proceeds in the Hole-in-One Insurance Fund, providing the golfer had previously contributed his \$5 entry fee. *Also, multiple holes-in-one occurring on either or both days will split the proceeds in the Hole-In-One Insurance Fund.* The Men's Club will not provide any additional subsidy.

Posting Scores:

Players will <u>not</u> post their scores in the Club Championship event. The Handicap Committee will post all scores as Tournament Scores. Standard ESC procedures will be followed in posting.
