Posting Rounds Played at Clubs Which are Not Part of GHIN System

Attention members of more than one club (handicap system). If you belong to a golf club that is not a part of the GHIN system, you may now report your score only once and it will be reflected on both systems. The procedure is simple if done correctly.

First, you must advise the Shadow Hills Men's Club of your other Association Name and Member Number (or IGN Number) by email to DHooper101@aol.com. We will input that into the GHIN System which will forward your scores posted to your other Association.

Second, you must advise your other Association of your GHIN number and that you are a member of the Southern California Golf Association. Notice, you are not a member of GHIN as that is not a local Association, but is a USGA computer operation.

The score you post on either system from then on will be forwarded, but might take a few days to be properly entered. So, no more need for you Canadians to post to two separate systems.
